The Tri-Town Ice Arena and the Junior Monarchs are proud to announce the times and dates for the “Mini” Monarchs Program for the 2010-11 season. After an extremely successful first two seasons, we are excited to continue to offer your child the best Learn to Play Hockey experience around. This program is dedicated to the proper skill development of young ice hockey players, with an emphasis on having fun. Jeremy Vega, Junior Monarchs Director of Player Development and Coaching, will again direct the program. It is intended for children ages 4-9. Older skaters can apply at Director’s discretion. Players entering Mini Monarchs should have some basic skating skills. They should be able to skate up and down the ice at a decent rate and be able to stop. If you have any questions about your child’s ability, please contact the director. The program will meet twice a week. Wednesday night sessions will consist of a skills practice and Saturday mornings will consist of skills and cross-ice games as the session progresses. This cost of the program is only \$169, less than \$8.50 per ice time. Your child will also receive a Public Skating Punch Card good for 10 free skates (**valued at \$60**); this allows your child **twenty more hours of free ice** to practice their skating. In addition, you will save money if you sign up multiple children or for multiple sessions at once and if you refer a new skater at the end of your session, you will receive a \$25 credit toward your next program at Tri-Town Ice Arena.

Mini Monarchs will run at convenient times for your family.

Director- Jeremy Vega, New Hampshire Jr. Monarchs- Director of Player Development and Coaching

Jeremy serves as the Assistant Program Director and the Player Development/ Coaching Director of the New Hampshire Junior Monarchs Youth Hockey Organization. He has been directing Learn to Play Hockey and Mite Programs for eight years. Coach Vega feels it is important to ensure the participants in these grassroots programs are having fun and learning proper skill development. Since coming on board in his current position, in 08-09, the Learn to Play Hockey Program has grown significantly, over 100%, and because of this our travel program has added a new mite team, the Mite – Intro to Travel team, which has been made up predominantly of players from our Mini Monarchs program. In addition, in 2010-11 we will introduce our Mite Development Program.

During the 2007-08 season, he worked as a teacher and the Assistant Boys' Varsity Ice Hockey Coach at Tilton School. He was part Tilton's most successful season as a Division I -New England Prep School Program. The Rams finished 24-8, two players were placed into Division I schools and a number of others went onto play Junior A and at Division III institutions. In years past, Jeremy coached at many different levels in the Junior Monarchs Organization, including: head coach at both the Mite and Peeewe levels and assistant coach at the Midget level. In addition to his duties with the travel program, he is the Program Director of Youth House League, Mini Monarchs and Summer Skills Sessions and has been an assistant coach on the junior ‘B’ team. Jeremy had the opportunity to coach at the 2006 USA Hockey National Select 15 Camp, the 2006, 2007 and 2010 USA Hockey Yankee Conference Festival and the 2007 and 2009 USA Hockey Jr. B Nationals, where the Jr. Monarchs placed runner-up and third place respectively. Jeremy places a high emphasis on player development and creating a culture conducive to players’ reaching their potential as individuals and teammates. Jeremy holds a USA Hockey Master Level V Coaching Certification.
